



## RNANT/NU Employer Information: Expedited License

The applicant must complete and submit:

- ✓ Payment Authorization Form
- ✓ RN/NP Expedited Applications: [Click here](#)
- ✓ Government photo identification: A current copy of their Drivers License or Passport, scanned in color and emailed to RNANT/NU.
- ✓ Name Change Documents: Marriage or Divorce documents to be scanned and emailed to RNANT/NU [info@rnantnu.ca](mailto:info@rnantnu.ca)

The Registrar will complete the following:

- ✓ To expedite the registration process a verbal and/or online confirmation will be done for employer references and jurisdictional verifications.
- ✓ If the applicants verifications or references are unsatisfactory, their registration may be delayed or denied.
- ✓ English Equivalency Exam: Please note that applicants who have not worked in an English speaking/writing environment for the last two years and who wrote their exam in French will be required to complete this process. This exam is only available in southern locations and can take several weeks to be completed.

### Employer Reminders

- This registration is valid for 90 days, or when the emergency is declared over.
- This registration cannot be renewed.
- If the employee chooses to remain in the NT/NU they will need to complete the RN Initial (Applicants Portal) or Reinstatement package found online.

If you would like to call for updates on the status of the registration the Information Sharing Consent form, located on our website, will need to be completed by the applicant and provided to RNANT/NU.
